The video game tester then completes the entire game and returnâ€™s the survey with any issues or bugs they encountered. Upon receiving the survey the gaming company will then mail the video game tester a check.

There are constantly new gaming platformâ€™s being introduced " the most recent being Nintendo Wii - which in turn increases the demand for video game testers. Furthermore traditionally there is the greatest need in summer for video game tester jobs. The reason behind this is a lot of gaming companies push for a Christmas release- meaning the QA phase needs to be completed months in advance to meet this deadline.
